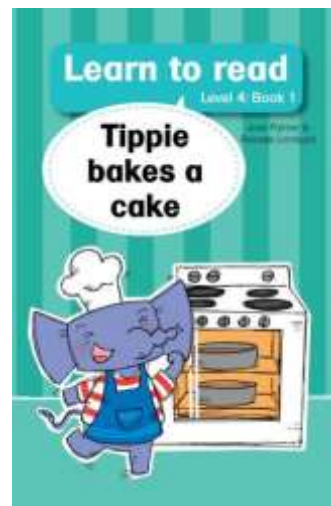


Level 4 Tippie bakes a cake - Book 1
